## Tournament Description

- Round Robin Format of Doubles Teams
- Our goal is 6 teams per group, which will result in 5 matches per team minimum
- Men's Doubles (8:00 AM to 11:00AM)
- Women's Doubles (8:00 AM to 11:00AM)
- Mixed Doubles (12:00 PM to 4:00PM)
- Number of games is based on registration
- Group Games Played to 11, must win by one (first team to score 11 points wins)

Group Winners will be determined by total wins per Team. If there is a tie, the first tie breaker will be total points for all games played. The second tie breaker will be point differential (the difference between your score and your opponents score for all games played).

For divisions with 2 groups, the top 2 from each group will advance to the semifinals. Winners from the semifinal will play in the finals for the overall division championship. Losers from the semifinals will play in the consolation match to determine the $3^{\text {rd }}$ place team. The semifinal will be played to 15 (win by 2 ). The final is best 2 out of 3 , played to 11 (win by 2 ).

For divisions with 4 groups, the top 2 from each group will advance to the quarterfinals. Winners of the quarterfinals will advance to the semifinals. Winners from the semifinal will play in the finals for the overall division championship. Losers from the semifinals will play in the consolation match to determine the $3^{\text {rd }}$ place team. The quarterfinals and semifinals will be played to 15 (win by 2 ). The final is best 2 out of 3 , played to 11 (win by 2 ).

All start times are subject to change and some groups may overlap. Number of games played will be based on group registration. Based on registration at the discretion of the tournament committee groups may cancelled. Groups cancelled by the committee will receive a full refund.
